


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FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY'S DESK

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Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

It gives me a great pleasure to greet you and connect with you once again through this issue of Chalk and Chai. Indeed, we have to be grateful to God for His grace and mercy that has enabled the educational institutions to conduct the final exams and to gradually get back to a normal functioning rhythm. Praise God! The activities of ETF are also slowly building up in a few places in the country and the publishing of Chalk and Chai has been carried out without any break.

During this year we have been focusing on the themes: 'Teacher and Sports', 'Teacher and Visual arts', 'Teacher and Literary Arts' and 'Teacher and Performing Arts'.

While we focus on the theme. 'Teacher and Literary Arts' in this issue, I would like to share the four components of the Bible as Literature which will help us to understand that God has the best store of literary arts in the Bible that can bring transformation in the lives of people and for building His kingdom on this earth.

Unity in Diversity

We know that the word *Bible* comes from the Greek word biblia, which means "the books." The modern English Bible consists of 66 books written by about 40 different authors from diverse backgrounds over a period of 15 centuries. The diversity of these authors is quite remarkable. To consider just a few: Moses was a shepherd and a leader; David was a shepherd and musician; Isaiah was a prophet; Ezra was a priest; Matthew was a tax collector; Peter and John were fisherman; Luke was a doctor; Paul was a tentmaker. so on and so forth. From a literary point of view, it is absolutely astonishing that despite having been written by so many authors over a period of 1500 years, the Bible does not contradict itself and does not contain any errors as it was originally written. It contains remarkable Unity in Diversity. The novelist Frederick Buechner in 'A Complete Literary Guide to the Bible' quotes: "In spite of all its extraordinary variety, the Bible is held together by having a single plot".

Unique Language

Some believe that the scientific mind-set has had a detrimental effect on

the power of modern language. But the Bible as great literature is guite unique in the sense that while there is a tremendous growth in technology, great changes in customs and languages, the vocabulary at present, contains a host of words that simply did not exist when the Bible was being written, neither has the human condition changed. As great literature that stands the test of time, the Bible is not handicapped by its lack of modern terminology. The unchanging Truth expounded in the pages of the Bible has made it the best seller of all times to be used by any age group, in any part of the world, in any language, at any time.

Unique Impact

The Bible also contains specific poetic works. Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes and the Song of Solomon are five specific poetic books in addition to much poetic phraseology found in many of the other books as well. For example, Jesus read directly from Isaiah chapter 61 which was originally written in Hebrew poetry, the poetic structure recognizable in the English version. He found the place where it was written: "'The Spirit of the LORD is upon me, because He has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD'" (Luke 4:17-19). However, these verses weren't written just for the poetry, nor did Jesus recite them specifically for their poetic beauty or impact.

The prophet Isaiah used poetry to convey the message, and Jesus' audience was similarly aware of its style.

But the **message** itself was what was most important. Similarly, the opening verse of Psalm 42 shows that even when the Bible uses a simile or metaphor in its poetry (referred to as emblematic parallelism), it is still evident that the **message** is paramount and the poetry is merely the vehicle. As another example of the Bible as literature, Biblical commentators refer to Psalm 8 as a meditative poem and this observation suggests that David almost certainly sang this psalm while playing the lute or harp. The first and last phrases of this poem are identical-they form a frame for profound ideas concerning God's essential being and His work on earth. This kind of literature can have a powerful impact on the reader.

Dr. Evangeline in her article, "And He saw that it was very good...!" expresses how the beauty of God's creative works in nature can be appreciated through her poetry class.

Unique Purpose

While the Bible contains specific literary and poetic sections, we need to keep in mind that the primary purpose of the whole Bible is for God to reveal Himself and to communicate with us through the authors to get the message across. The Bible as the best outstanding literature of the world stands not for the sake of making good literature but is used for specific purposes and these purposes are clearly expounded in many places in the Bible itself. While we appreciate the beauty of God's Word, let us enhance our study of it as we seek to know God and apply His Word in our lives.

May the Lord enable us to be unique in our communication and to use our skills to fulfill His purpose in proclaiming the Truth through our classroom Teachings.



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
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We all marvel at the splendor of God's creation. The glorious sunrise, the twittering birds, the smiling flowers, the mesmerizing woods, the gentle breeze, tides on the seashore, the colored sky during sunset, the mountains and valleys... every little thing, great or small around us proclaim the magnificence of His divine wisdom and creativity. God so loved the world that He wanted it to be crowned with beauty, brimming with life.



As a professor of English Literature, I mostly teach subjects related to nature, beauty and love. All of these are gifted to us by God and He expects us to cherish these gifts and thank and praise Him each day. Whenever I teach a poem or a literary piece that talks about nature, I wonder at the brilliance of God's creation because every poet talks of how nature has influenced his life in many ways. William Wordsworth, the muchloved British poet in his popular poem "I Wandered Lonely as a Cloud" happens to see a meadow filled with beautiful vellow daffodils. He admires the beauty of those flowers and once he goes back home, he muses on how the sight of these flowers affect him in a positive way. He says:

"For oft, when on my couch I lie In vacant or in pensive mood, They flash upon that inward eye Which is the bliss of solitude; And then my heart with pleasure fills, And dances with the daffodils."

Don't we feel the same, when we happen to see something beautiful around us? Hence, John Keats, another famous poet in his poem "Endymion"

says: "A thing of beauty is a joy forever."

God communicates to man through nature. Every sight and sound, sense and smell tell us of God's unconditional love for mankind. Amidst our chaotic life on earth, nature serves as a source of solace to us; it gives us joy and assuran-

ce and silently declares His promise to provide for us. Luke 12: 27-28 says: "Look at the lilies and how they grow. They don't work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. And if God cares so wonderfully for flowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith?" A simple wildflower stands as a testimony of God's love! When we start worrying about tomorrow, the Bible says: "Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?" (Matthew 6: 26-27)

When nature trusts the love of God blindly, why don't we humans trust His might? Why do we worry, doubt, fret and fear? He has engraved us in His palm; He collects our tears in His bottle. The Bible

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is full of God's promises: "Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget, I will not forget you! See, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands; your walls are ever before Me." (Isaiah 49:15-16) God never wants us to be unhappy; on the other



hand, He wants us to trust in His unfailing love, cast our burdens on Him and listen to His gentle voice echoing through nature. John Masefield, a popular English poet thus beautifully sums up in his poem "Laugh and be Merry":

"Laugh and be merry: remember, in olden time.
God made Heaven and Earth for joy He took in a rhyme,
Made them, and filled them full with the strong red wine of His mirth
The splendid joy of the stars: the joy of the earth.

So we must laugh and drink from the deep blue cup of the sky, Join the jubilant song of the great stars sweeping by, Laugh, and battle, and work, and drink of the wine outpoured In the dear green earth, the sign of the joy of the Lord."

I was 18 years old when I accepted our Lord Jesus Christ as my personal Saviour. Although I born and brought up in a Christian home, this was a turning point in my life. I wouldn't say that my journey of faith has been highly commendable. I have failed several times, slipped and stumbled on numerous occasions. But through this wibbly wobbly journey of faith, I can see God's love enfold me. When my faith was severely tested and I sat in shocked despair, God's love and care surrounded me and He kept me and my family "safe in His dwelling ... in the shelter of His tabernacle" (Ps. 27:5); when I was lost in worldly cares, His right hand held me fast and turned my heart to Him. As Francis Thompson says in his beautiful poem, "The Hound of Heaven", (which is based on Psalm 139) God's majestic footsteps have followed me and pulled me back to Him time after time. I love how the Psalmist has beautifully said, "Where can I go from Your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?" (Ps 139:7)

Through all my ups and downs, one of the constant thoughts in my mind has

been about sharing the good news of the gospel with everyone. In the initial days of my salvation my heart would ache when I looked at people around me and thought of them living without Christ. As the years rolled by, the cares of the world dulled this ache but the desire to share my faith has never gone away completely.

In a most remarkable way, God opened a way for me to share the gospel through my teaching career during which I have had the opportunity to integrate faith in both a literature and a language classroom. Literature classes offer endless opportunities to share our faith. I thank God for showing me how I could integrate these into my lectures. Very often one phrase or one anecdote would trigger my evangelical conscience and I would immediately veer off to explain to my class the basis of my faith and the faith of all Christians. I noticed during these times, that many did not know anything about Jesus or if they did, they did not know the reason for His coming to earth. And so, I tried to give as clear a picture of the gospel as I could.

Literature classes can be used to share many stories from the Bible as there are a number of references to great biblical characters and events in most works of literature, especially, in the great classics. When we have a good knowledge of the Bible it is easy to recognize expressions from the Bible as writers in earlier times were very familiar with the Bible and freely used many biblical passages or ideas to effectively express themselves in their works.

As any teacher of literature would agree, there is an amazing collection of works that reflect Christian themes. Right from openly professing books on Christianity such as *Pilgrim's Progress* to books masking faith under various symbolisms such as the works of C.S. Lewis, these books have been my joy and delight. Milton's *Paradise Lost* was another work that I enjoyed teaching students as it provided ample scope to discuss the Christian faith.

One year I was asked to teach "Murder in the Cathedral" by T.S. Eliot. I was thrilled to notice the number of Biblical references and needless to say I had a truly wonderful time teaching it to my undergraduate class. When I look back, I realize that almost every book that I taught opened a small door through which I could slip into a discussion on the Bible or biblical values. For instance, a paper on feminism afforded a wonderful opportunity to explain God's purpose in creating man and woman and dispel many false notions that were being taught through those lessons. It would take too long to list all the works that I have used in a literature class and so I have restricted myself to these few references.

faith in a language class. I particularly enjoyed having discussions on the origin of language when the class would explore the various theories surrounding the origin of language in man. After much discussion, which eventually ended in the realization that, there was no concrete evidence to tell us how language actually developed. I would focus on the divine source theory that states that language was given to man by God Himself. The answer to a question on the development of different languages again can be traced to the incident at the Tower of Babylon when God confounded the plans of men by giving them different languages so that one man could not understand the instruction of another man and the ambitious project of building a tower reaching the heavens had to be abandoned. This again, opened avenues to discuss my faith journey and encourage the faith of my students.

I also found that I could integrate

When we look at how the world is hurtling towards a Godless, self-seeking generation, sharing the gospel has taken on a new urgency. It is my prayer that God will bless each one of us with the discernment to grab every opportunity to share His word. And to all teachers of language and literature – there are innumerable ways in which we can integrate faith in the lessons we teach!! May God bless us with His heart of love that will constantly have us seeking to bring people to Him.



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Language Teaching

as Tent-making in a closed country



(There are names that cannot be named here for security reasons as there are people and work going on that can be affected.)

Times are changing very fast. And it is headed towards the world becoming more hostile to the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, and also more alien to the Christian world view. There is an air of urgency as windows are closing everywhere. Even while they are open, there is a need for creative witness and urgency to impact as much as possible in whatever little time is given. Situations around the world are so fluid that suddenly it is possible to find yourself stopped or shut out from your field.

This sums up my wife's and my experience in a closed country for 12 vears which clanged shut its door to us while we were vacationing in a neighbouring country when Covid-19 had started forcing countries to close down their borders and we decided to wait it out at home in India. been able to go back ever since. We came away with only holiday clothes. Much later our important possessions like personal documents were mailed to us. That country is yet to open up to Indians.

In the year 2009, my wife and I with our youngest daughter flew to a new field to teach the English language at a very top notch university. We had been accepted as members of a North American professional teachers' organization consisting of committed Christians and which sent teachers to countries where witnessing was acutely required. This organization had established quite a reputation in the countries it had already entered and teachers coming through it were accepted without reservation. Wherever these teachers taught, there was a demand for more which the organization could not meet.

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Right from the time of induction, we were familiarized with what was ahead of us and what to expect. We were told we would be heading into a situation where conventional ways of evangelism would not be at all possible. In fact, it was drummed into us that we would not be allowed to openly share the gospel with just anyone. And in our organisational communiqués, we were not even allowed to use words like 'God' or 'church' or 'Jesus Christ'; not even in email or through phones. Everything was monitored strictly by the State. We were trained not to directly share the gospel or even directly approach any citizen of that country with the gospel in any form! I remember being amazed by this rule. How on earth were we to make the good news available then?!

However, when we entered the country and got familiar with life in that country, particularly its strict authoritarian rule of government, I understood the wisdom of the modus operandi of our organization. The university authorities made it very clear multiple times that we should concern ourselves only with the matter of teaching, and to avoid politics and religion, especially with the students. Later, we got to learn that every class had a monitor who reported directly to the political secretary of the university on any political or religious episodes in the class. It was also a new experience to find CCTV cameras that recorded what was written on the black board and said in class.

The approach adopted by our organization which every teacher inclined to follow and live by was to focus on being excellent in teaching as well as in living, rather than speaking out our faith straight away. This strategy was

creative for the situation we found ourselves in that country where it was against the law to talk about and engage in religion, and where the ordinary student was an atheist. They would be so incredulous to encounter teachers who had religion because in their mind religion was an occupation of the superstitious. With such a milieu whose psyche had been effectively sanitized against religion, the thought of the existence of the spirit world is 'unscientific'. How do you even start to open their minds to God then?

According to our organization, it has to be by our excellent life and professionalism in the sight of our target group. This is a creative approach. By being excellent in profession and exemplary living there will be attraction of attention to why you are different from others. And when someone notices you are different and asks you why it is so, there you have the opening for giving your reasons as to why you believe what you believe, which is the reason why you are different! The excellence of Christ cannot be slurred by the mediocre life and behaviour of His nominees was the bar that was set for teachers of that organization.

In practice, this translated into having to spend hours every day for the day's lessons although it might be a rehash and you have taught it several times already; reading up new developments on techniques and ideas, learning technical stuff to back up your assertions, the history of things, and finding better ways of explaining things to the level and in the culture of your students, etc., to dressing decently for every class, and being on time every time, to never showing ugly attitudes and responses

even in very trying situations. Racism is found everywhere and this can create ugly scenes or atmospheres when it raises its head. Being the only Indian (coloured) foreign teacher among white teachers who taught English and being from a country that is not native English, I faced some bad situations but I worked even harder to be excellent in my work to compensate for all my deficiencies I could not help. The Lord vindicated me when in the second year of teaching I was chosen for the honour of receiving the Provincial award for my services as a teacher. And being true to the code of service of our organization, my wife and I never took a day of leave for all the years we taught. We never got any adverse report from our students for our work, and our employers consequently exhibited confidence in us to the extent that, although they preferred hiring westerners as English teachers, we were told they would like to have us teach as long as we desired to. We enjoyed very good relationships all around.

Now did the strategy of being excellent work the way it was expected to? Yes, it did in many ways. It created a confidence in the university authorities on us in such a way that we were given liberal opportunities to 'academically' present safe extents of the gospel, like during Christmas and other special events, we were allowed to hold Christmas carols where carols were sung and later were able to invite people over to our private apartments to give a more expanded story of Christmas. We were allowed to conduct visitation hours where students could come to our apartments to 'practise' English when we could talk hard stuff on many occasions. There were many students who would regularly come back just to enjoy our home atmosphere and listen to our world view. Over the years of such associations, we have sowed the seed of the Word in the lives of many students. A few became Christians and more began to question their life. One particular visitor would come over when she felt low because she said she felt love in our home.

Language teaching is a powerful tool for Kingdom work and witness. It affords the passport to access countries and regions that have not heard the good news because interest in learning the English language is acutely felt everywhere. You can intentionally pick language learning topics for your class lesson that bring up conversations that can lead to deeper searches and more meaningful conversations. And if you are willing to sacrifice some of your free time, you can invite students over for socializing which can lead to intentional topics. We gave two hours of our time every Tuesday which became the backbone to identifying students who seemed to hunger for more than they knew. Much of our relationships were the result of these two hours of our lives. Two hours that translated to eternity for those who got to hear the gospel.

We have One who is our Teacher, the Christ (*Matthew 23:8*) who we reflect as teachers.





What is there to make yourself so proud when you yourself form a point particle existing in this indefinite space. You constitute the set of complexities which need the very 'n' dimensional equations to be solved. Whatever you achieve can leave you feeling helpless unless it is held by the strongest force, which in human life may be compared with the impeccable values as those of love, sincerity, honesty, truth, trust, passion etc. "Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up", says the scripture (James 4 :10). Remember, you are a relative particle existing in this space with the most probable uncertainty around you. Whatever comes into your life will mold you since the creator knows all the things you can overcome, either by jumping or by tunneling. You can face the potential before you and do



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remember that when you succeed, it's a joint action of the infinite space around you. Be humble, be honest, be loving because you are unique the way you are and no one else can occupy your fingerprint region. Psalms 139:13-14 says "You alone created my inner being. You knitted me together inside my mother. I will give thanks to you because I have been so amazingly and miraculously made. Your works are miraculous, and my soul is fully aware of this".

As a child, I always dreamed of becoming a teacher. By God's grace, I was able to teach in a school in Aizawl, Delhi, Bangalore and Dehradun over the past 20 years. I am grateful for God's grace and guidance.

I began my career as a Nursery teacher, and I loved teaching and interacting with these toddlers as they wandered out of their mother's protective cocoon into the world. A smile on their faces when you tie their shoe laces is invaluable, as is a hug and comfort when they feel like guests in their unknown surroundings. One day a little girl came to me and told me "Ma'am, you look like a small mother". I will always treasure that moment (as a teenager, I used to be teased and judged for my height, but now a tiny angel tells me that size doesn't matter. My student sees a mother in me.)

of interaction with my students listening to their stories and learning their secrets was fun.

The middle section provided me with yet another opportunity to deal with a lot of extra energy and unwavering stamina. They tend to deplete your energy to the point where you have to start over the next day.

Coming to senior high school has given me a glimpse of the rebellious adolescent in need of nurturing and care. Every day, I would remind myself of my favorite verse: "I can do all things through Christ which strengthened me" Philippians 4:13.

Through all these years, I have tried my best to identify and maneuver my student's hidden talents and skills.

I regularly reminded my students that "God created man in His own image..." - Genesis 1:27. God has given each one of us unique abilities, talents, and gifts. The question is how do we put them to work? When I invited a third-grade student to be the narrator for a short skit, he declined because he believed he had stage fright and would be unable to stand in front of the entire school. I told him that practice makes a man perfect and that we could do anything through Christ who strengthens us. Later, he assumed the role and performed admirably. Our students sometimes require prompting and encouragement in order to discover their skills and talents.

I have tried to incorporate learning activities that enable students to demonstrate their potential in a unique way. Students with literary talent, for example, can demonstrate their potential by producing poems, novels, or descriptive prose; some students can study historical figures and conduct indepth analyses of individual leaders.

In this way, students have the opportunity to demonstrate critical thinking and interest, as well as initiative

and ability in planning, organizing and leadership. Above all, I did my utmost to notice and encourage indicators of talent by praising them.

Yes, teaching can be a Herculean task at times, but we must seek and ask God for His guidance and assistance so that we can make a positive difference in the lives of our students.

I thank God for this wonderful experience to make a small contribution in His kingdom.

Let us be truthful in our labor and acknowledge God, and do our best for God's Kingdom. God Bless.

It was indeed quite exciting to organise the conference in Tamil Nadu after a two-year break due to the pandemic. I praise God for His grace and guidance to conduct the conference and am thankful to all the delegates who attended the conference. Special thanks to the organisations and individuals who encouraged their teachers to attend the conference.

About 40 delegates including the facilitators and 4 children(boys) attended the conference. The representation from different places namely Chennai, Madurai, Coimbatore, Pavoorchatram, Rajapalayam, Kadayam and Ambasamuthram in Tamil Nadu, from the neighbouring states Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh and from Bihar was greatly encouraging.

The theme of the conference was "Teachers – Fragrance for Christ" (2 Cor.2:15). The conference began with a time of singing led by Dr. Jayanth Jacob from Chennai.
