



1. Song of Mary

Mary was quite an young girl and she was engaged to Joseph to get married. But when Christ's birth was announced to Mary, like any other young girl, Mary was first questioning but finally she submitted to God's will. Mary had learned to forget the world's common prayer, 'Thy will be changed' and learned to pray the world's greatest prayer - 'Thy will be done'. When Elizabeth greeted Mary, Mary's expression of her submission to God's will evolved in the form of a sweet and calm hymn of adoration, 'Mary's Magnificat'. According to the interpretation given by Bro. Stanley Jones, this song is the most revolutionary document in the world for it speaks of 3 revolutions of God. First one is the Moral revolution where God scatters the proud in the plans of their hearts. Experiencing Christ is the death of pride because if we set our lives beside the life of Christ, it tears the last vertigo of pride from us. It is a wonderful thing that the first announcement of God should come to the shepherds. The shepherds were simple common illiterate people. They were despised by the traditional orthodox religious leaders. God could have sent only audio communication to the shepherds. But God was interested in angels to leave their comfort zone to render the heavenly music and share the good news with these simple common people. In simple faith, the shepherds received the message, made haste to experience Christ.

There are still a quite a lot of despised community in India deprived of education. There are many Christian schools in remote areas of India where there is a vital need for Christian teachers to work as tent makers. There are many opportunities to be "Tourism Teachers" to go and teach our subjects in such schools during our vacation time including Christmas vacation.

Dear friends, the song of angels reminds us that we are called to leave our comfort zone to **build up** the illiterate community with education and with gospel truth.

Think of the blend in building - 'Jesus Others You' and that is the JOY of Christmas!

When this issue of Chalk and Chai is received by you I am sure that we would have come almost to the end of this year 2018. Let us thank our dear Lord with a grateful heart for His faithfulness, grace and guidance that has helped us to travel our life journey through this year.

CHRISTMAS SEASON

Questions to consider during this

My dear ETF Family,

Christmas Greetings!

Two thousand years ago, "Joy to the World, the Lord is come!" was sung. May those words give you meaning and joy this season as you celebrate it with your family and friends in your circle of influence.

It is my delight to bring you a seasonal message on this occasion. As I've been meditating I was led to consider 5 questions to help direct our perspective:

What does history say about Christmas?

While the very day, the 25th of December is not the exact day on which Jesus was born, the historicity of the birth of Jesus is very strong. Look at how Luke sets the stage of the story of the birth of Jesus.

In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. (This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was governor of Syria.) And everyone went to their own town to register. (Luke 2:1-3)

In the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar—when Pontius Pilate was governor of Judea, Herod tetrarch of Galilee, his brother Philip tetrarch of Iturea and Traconitis, and Lysanias tetrarch of Abilene during the high-priesthood of Annas and Caiaphas, the word of God came to John son of Zechariah in the wilderness. (Luke 3:1-2)

Luke mentions many prominent rulers and leaders of different provinces for a reason. For example, if you were performing a drama on the birth of Jesus taking from the account of Luke, you would certainly use the roles of prominent leaders like Ceasar and Pontius Pilate. Other leaders are mentioned: Philip tetrarch of Iturea, Traconitis, Lysanias tetrarch of Abilene, and Quirinius the governor of Syria. What role will you give them to play in your drama?

Luke identifies the point of time when the said event took place by ascertaining the time when different rulers ruled in different capacities. For example, if we say something took place when Modi was the PM of India, Trump was the President of the USA or Xi Jinping was the President of China it proves the event historically. Thus, history is the witness of the birth of Jesus.

What does the contemporary world say about Christmas?

The world has remodeled Christmas to suit the tastes and ideals of

e time. The glittering decorations of malls, commercial facilities and airports with reindeer, chariots of Santa Claus, Christmas trees, and presents have taken over the understanding of Christmas. Upon being asked what the meaning of Christmas was, here are a few responses received: "It is the birth of Ishaa Mahesh", "It was the birth of mother Jesus", and a shop keeper replied, "It is the best business season of the year."

What does the contemporary church say about Christmas?

Charles Dickens wrote: "How many old recollections and sympathies does Christmas time awaken?" Many churches have held unto the old traditions of Christmas while many other churches have remodeled Christmas to their own tastes of the time with decoration, food, carol singing with a Santaclaus, stars, Christmas trees, nativity stories, dramas, dances and cultural activities. A few churches take the opportunity to reach out to their friends and circle of influence with the gospel of Christ.

What does God say about Christmas?

The eternally existing Word became flesh and pitched a tent in our neighborhood. One who created time and space and was/is never affected by them, brought Himself under the influence of time and space. The Creator took the form of Creature to show us with his perfect example how to spend our limited time towards what will affect our eternity. He came as was planned eternally for our sake. Hence, as someone has said:

The plan of redemption was drawn in eternity.

The redeemer was appointed.

The gospel that was to be preached was ordained.

L-Lead and leave a legacy

D – Desire, Develop and Delegate.

Be – Be as you are. While the world is challenging us to put us into its own mold and shape. Bible tells us to be who we are in God and in Christ. Paul writes. Imitate me, just as I imitate Christ (I Cor 11:1). Before fighting Goliath, David said to King Saul, let me be - Me. It is good to remember that we need to be ourselves. God can use our talents as we are, as we come to Him in humility and adoration. God can use you as a "tool" in His hand. That is the best thing that can happen to you and me.

In mid 80's, I left my job in Indian Railways and took up full time ministry of – Teaching and Training. People said, 'you are not "fit" -- you are not ready'. Seek Him and find Him, He is near and dear to you.

Unique- Remember you are "unique". You are the only one like you. In a world with a population of over 7 billion people there is no other person with your finger print and optical nerve design. Is it not a miracle? You are unique! Your five fingers are different but unique, each has a function to play. They are unique so are you because God has made you! The Bible affirms this message over and over so that we would "build" ourselves up and help others.

Intelligent Investment

In life there are many investments: Gold bars, Diamonds, Fixed deposits, lands and house assets but the intelligent investment is investing your life with God and being used by Him. That is why Jesus said, Seek first the Kingdom of God and all these things shall be added unto you.

L-Lead and leave a legacy

Dr. Bob Clinton, Professor at Fuller Theological Seminary in California, USA wrote a book – *Making of a Leader*. In that book he mentions that the greatest famine in the world is – Leadership. God has equipped you with good education, opportunities, potentials and talents. Use your Leadership. There is so much of need for leadership. I remember in late 90's I was in North East India in a remote place, we were delayed due to



insurgence problems. But when we reached the destination, I had the opportunity to "teach and train" 10 staff workers of World Vision. They were over-joyed that they got leadership tools for them which they needed. You can lead and equip others to lead.

In the Bible we see leaders equipping others to lead: Moses – Joshua, Elijah – Elisa, Daniel – 3 friends, Jesus -- Disciples, Disciples – Paul, Paul – Timothy, and Timothy – faithful men.

The things [the doctrine, the precepts, the admonitions, the sum of my ministry] which you have heard me teach in the presence of many witnesses, entrust [as a treasure] to reliable and faithful men who will also be capable and qualified to teach others. 2 Tim 2:2

Leave a legacy: Leadership is not for one individual, one group or few groups. It is for one generation to the other. It goes on and on. You can be part of it. God has a plan for you that way. It is up to you to take it.

D – Desire, Develop and Delegate.

To leave a legacy we need to "build" one. To build a legacy we need to constantly and consistently work. We need to have an unquenchable desire – a desire that will not die easily, a desire that will tide over waves of trouble and obstacles all the times. Development is hard work. You organize your thoughts, make an outline, expand a thought or a topic. Create a power point. Make charts and graphs or any method to convey the concepts clearly and graphically. Use modern tools, go to professionals who can do that for you. It

would cost you but your presentation will be excellent and professional. People will see you have taken pains and have put them well.

Delegate- We can multiply leaders through the process of – Delegation. I am always amazed at the level of confidence Jesus had on his disciples who were simple fishermen. He trained them and left the task of evangelism to them. He delegated His work.

¹⁸ Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."Mt 28:18-20

An imaginary story is told by Dr. Oral Roberts. I believe when Jesus returned to heaven there was a great reception because He has done a great job of getting Salvation for the world. The angels asked Jesus, "Please give a word, 10,000 angels will go and do your work. We can be invisible, we can fly, we can be in many places and we do not have human restriction". Jesus told them, "I have my friends, my disciples." The angels laughed. Is it not Peter who denied you? Is it not the disciples who all ran away except John? Jesus gave them one answer- I trust them.

God is trusting you, my friend to build others for him. He has given you a forum in your teaching setting to do that. Use it as it is said, "we either use it or lose it". God be with you.



We are living in a self-serving, self-centred, and self-obsessed modern day rush society filled with negativity and constant tearing down of others. There is a general pursuit of position and possession. The biggest problem in the world today is not the scarcity of resources but the scarcity of people who are truly concerned about others and helping others to grow. This kind of attitude of people was clearly foretold by God in 2 Timothy Chapter 3.

It's not difficult to build others up, especially since we have been given the fruit of the Spirit through Jesus Christ. We encourage others even when our own situations are tough because we enter into every day with a thankful heart and the presence of God.

God is looking for the kind of followers who are living a life of true commitment to the Lord and sincere love and concern for others. We all know John 3:16 by heart: 'God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.' But usually ignore 1 John 3.16 "By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brothers." If we want to really make a difference in this world, then we ought to be peopleoriented and would focus on building others up.

Created as relational beings, it's our greatest privilege to enjoy companionship with the people who truly matter in our lives. How can we then be a source of encouragement to our students, friends, family, and loved ones today?

"Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing"

(1 Thessalonians 5:11)

People are around us every day at work, church, school, and even in our homes. Many of these same people are struggling every day by the words and actions of other people. Most of them are still hearing the hurtful words from their childhood. It is the grace of God that gives us what we need to overcome our own difficulty and become a source of encouragement to the hurting.

We are to take time for prayer and Bible study. Our arrival in the home, work, school, or neighbourhood should usher in a spirit of peace and joy because we are children of the King. "A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones" (Proverbs 17:22).

Here are few suggestions regarding building others up:

1. Esteem others better than yourself.

We are expected to accept one another as Christ has accepted us. Roman 15:7 says "receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God." Gen.1:27-28 says everyone is made in God's image. Unique and different. The moment we accept people as they are then people need not put up a mask. But the attitude 'I am better than others' creates a problem in the world today. Apostle Paul has

mentioned in Philippians 2.3 very practical aspect of taking care of others. Leaders, Teachers should esteem others even the students better than themselves. We should have high regards, great respect, and favourable thoughts of the people in our circle of trust and influence.

2. Be wise in your speech.

Communicate more effectively by thinking before we speak. If there's a word that's more appropriate in a conversation, use it. Start with a positive note. Never condemn students, staff and others even if you know the truth. Instead, point out on how both of you can make things better. Speak at the same level as your audience; giving them due respect. "Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone." Col 4:6

3. Be encouraging.

Every person goes through discouragement at times.

Hebrews 3:13 says:

Encourage one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

Barnabas has been called the son of encouragement, who had, many a time encouraged the believers.

4. Be quick to forgive.

Our natural tendency, when others make a mistake, is to judge and condemn. But we are expected to be quick to forgive and forget. The Lord Jesus has taught us in the Lord's Praver. Forgive our debts as we

Argive our debtors. James writes to the believers, "My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry" (James 1:19).

5. Be understanding.

Wisdom and understanding go hand in hand. Understanding starts by being an active listener (not planning a reply as one is speaking), asking intelligent questions to gain further insights. Then, answer without condemning. Or don't answer at all and just give a listening ear. Use your gifts from the Holy Spirit for discernment. "The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. For who knows a person's thoughts except their own spirit within them?" (1 Corinthians 2:10-11).

Pray even in the midst of a conversation that God will quicken our minds with the right words for the perfect moment.

6. Use God's Word:

God's word has answers for every situation in life. As believers we are given insight to the scriptures that can help strengthen and encourage other people.

7. Be positive:

Positive thinking goes beyond having the drive and motivation for personal success. Positive thinking is explicit, definite, and outspoken. It's contagious. Build up your loved ones with your positive attitude, allowing them to be open for better things to come. The Lord Jesus had already told his disciples 'In this world you

have tribulation but be of good cheer. I have overcome the world.'

8. Let love be genuine:

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not selfseeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails ... And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love." (1 Corinthians 13, NIV). Care for your loved ones how you would want to be cared for. Build up one another how you would like to be inspired. As a result, you will move up to a whole new level of breakthroughs in life.

Going one step further, visualize how and to whom you can build up and inspire changes for the better. Then work towards making that a reality.

Continue encouraging and building one another up. And start seeing growth and advancements in your relationship with people and to the ones who truly matter to you today. I am my brother's keeper.



The Master TEACHER





Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ was a Great Teacher and a wonderful Doctor when HE dwelt among us and fulfilled God's plan of salvation for the humankind. Till the first decade of the millennium many of His disciples took up teaching and health care as their calling. But sadly this trend is declining as the present day's youth prefer lucrative jobs in software industries to teaching. This has caused a paucity of Christian Teachers in academia. There is an urgency to consider teaching as a call, a vocation, a mission and not as a profession.

You are called to be a teacher...

God has placed a Teacher in an institution to play a comprehensive role in shaping the future generations which would destine the future of our land. A Christian Teacher has a two-fold call – to cater to the a) academic

and b) spiritual needs of the students. The primary calling is to impart knowledge to his/her wards by opening their minds and helping them discover the truth. Added to this a Christian Teacher's call is to open the spiritual eyes of his students, too. In the present time this should be done rather discreetly. "The Lord has assigned to each his task". v. 5. Though the context of this passage may be different, we can apply this to a teacher, too. There lies the beauty of the Scriptures. The teacher should have "one purpose." v. 8

1. Intellectual Growth:

A conscientious teacher prepares the ground and plants the seeds of knowledge, right from the students' pre-school days. Later another Christian teacher waters these and our Master Teacher makes them grow. Teaching is a group activity.

In the child matures, teachers are involved in various stages of learning.

2. Spiritual Growth:

A teacher should be concerned not only about his ward's immediate life but also his eternal life. The Christian Teacher has an additional responsibility to introduce Jesus Christ and impart biblical values whenever possible. There are various avenues to introduce Christ through various lessons like biology. physics, literature and the like. We may not be able to talk directly about Christ, but indirectly tell about Him. For instance, a biology teacher can start a healthy discussion about Creation. He can talk about the Theory of Evolution and expose the pitfalls in that. A Physics teacher can strengthen this argument by talking about the vastness of the universe. planets and stars and can show the students that we are yet to receive light from some stars which are far away. By this the teacher can make the students wonder-struck and can emphatically show that the creation would have been possible only by a Supernatural Being. A teacher of literature is at a great advantage in talking about God. He can even directly talk about God to the students. The Gospel of John, Milton's Paradise Lost and Paradise Regained, the Book of Job, the Psalms, Proverbs and the novels of Charles Dickens and Thomas Hardy are prescribed text books for the English literature students. What a golden opportunity to teach about Sin and the Fall of Mankind through Paradise Lost and God's provision of salvation through Paradise Regained. None can accuse the English

teacher as he only expounds these two great epics of John Milton. An alert teacher can make the best use of such opportunities. I have taught these genres of literature to my students and have presented the Gospel to them. The beauty of literature is that we can use these examples even in our preaching assignments in our Churches and in Evangelical Union and EGF gatherings. In all my devotions to prove that a Christian's life after conversion is not always a bed of roses. I start with the story The Cop and the Anthem by O. Henry. The Gift of the Magi by the same author will frequently find a place in my talk about agape love and in my Christmas messages. Thus literature can be used as a tool to open the spiritual eyes of the taught and also in our preaching assignments.

3. Teacher as a Role Model:

A student closely watches the lifestyle and behavior of the teacher. Next to his parents, the student learns guite a lot from the teacher. So it is imperative that the teacher guards his words, the way in which he dresses, the way in which he moves with his fellow-teachers and handles his wards. We can walk the talk by our exemplary Christian lifestyle, by showering unconditional love on our students, in motivating, encouraging and going the extra mile in coaching them. The students closely watch us. Whatever the teacher says is unassailable truth to them. You would have observed our children emphatically argue and ascertain what their teacher has said is correct even though it is wrong. They would simply refuse to be corrected because his teacher has said it. Such is the influence the teacher has on the young minds. Should not the teacher use that to instill Christian values and biblical truth in their formative years? Time is short, but our task is huge. A student remains with us only for one academic year, which is from 180 to 200 working days, for us to influence them. A teacher is always a learner. Only if he has a mastery over his subject and general knowledge he can be an effective teacher.

4. Mastery that matters

The Master Teacher, Our Lord Jesus Christ was different from the teachers of Law of HIS time. He taught with authority. Mt. 7: 28, 29. He was well-versed in the Books of the Law and the sayings of the prophets. 'Variety is the spice of life' goes an old saying. Jesus deployed variety of methods in HIS teachings and sermons. A diligent teacher should study hard, prepare well and deliver effectively in the class. The students can assess the quality of the teacher and judge even at the first class. When teachers from other faiths shine well as good teachers, how brighter a Christian teacher should be?

5. Landmarks and Signposts:


Rewards are assured to each teacher "according to his own labour" (v. 8) because we are "God's fellow workers" (v. 9). Christian teachers should always remember that he should give an account of what he has done in the institution he is placed. "... his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work. If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward. If it is burned up, he will suffer loss; he himself will be saved, but only as one escaping through the flames". 'Landmarks' tell you where you are and where you have come from whereas 'Signposts' point the way ahead. A teacher should not be satisfied or pride over the 'Landmarks', but he should follow the 'Signposts' and take his students along with him there.

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord not for men. Colossians 3:23

BUILDING SOMEONE

UP

Build someone up,
Put their insecurities to sleep,
Remind them they're worthy,
Tell them they are magical,
Be the light in a too often
dim world

So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual up building Romans 14:19(ESV)

Build! Build! Build! Build Someone up! It may just be a Word of Prayer; a Word of Encouragement; a pat on the back saying "Well Done"; or just lending anear to listen. It need not be a gargantuan task or deed; it can be just a small one but nevertheless a significant one. The scriptures are so full of verses that prompt us to rise up and build one another up, to build relationships... so let us not stop but keep building. When man can build such high rise structures, can we not reach the zenith contributing to build someone's life? All we need to do is, "CARE TO BUILD, CARE TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE". Question is, "How do we go about this?" Do we need the encouragement to do this? The greatest words of encouragement are the ones inspired by the Holy Spirit and as Jude says in 1:20, we need to be "Praying in the Holy Spirit".

We cannot begin to build another up unless we have built ourselves up on the firm foundation of the Word of God. As Christian teachers, every time we face a new generation of young people, we are blessed with yet another platform to impact this GenX and make a difference. We are given two relationships that we can foster:

a. Relationship within the Teaching Fraternity:

Proverbs 27:17 aptly says, "Iron sharpens iron and one man sharpens another" (ESV). As teachers, we are responsible to build ourselves up not only with respect to our discipline but also to strengthen our spiritual foundation, a foundation that stands (2 Timothy 2:19). And this foundation is on the Lord Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 3:11). Once this is in place alongside our core moral values, we are on track to mentor and stand alongside our colleagues and fellow teachers, ever ready to lend a helping hand that builds.

b. Relationship with our students

Our students are often times, the weaker ones. And it is our obligation to bear with their failings and help them stand up and press on. This is what the Word of God explicitly explains in **Romans 15:1-11**. It is important that the "God in us"rubs off on the people around us or we would have failed at utilising the teaching platform effectively and completely.

Some of the building blocks that aid in building up people and in turn, foster strong relationships are:

#1 Serving through Love

We have all been blessed with skills and gifts to use not just for ourselves but to serve others as said in **1 Peter 4:10** (As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace). This is a responsibility we are called to address and expedite with love in our hearts ("Through love serve one another" **Gal. 5:13**).

#2 Seeking Peace

Dwight L. Moody said, "A great many people are trying to make peace but that has already been done. God has not left it for us to do; all we have to do is to enter into it". Wise grains of wisdom!! Jesus Christ gave us a peace that the world could never offer us(John14:27). Let us capture and hold on to this peace and pursue things for peace(Romans 14:19:So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding).

#3 Speaking words of Encouragement

The Word of God says it best in **1 Thess. 5:11**, "Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing) and in **Hebrews 3:13** which says, "But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin". One encouraging word could bring a smile and make somebody's day worth living.

#4 Exercise Self-restraint and Grace

Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear...**Ephesians 4:29.**



Ris is a tricky one because we are always upfront to voice our opinions, our ideas but the key here is to tone down on our ideas, our plans and seek out His plans, His ways. Let us remind ourselves that we are just tools in the Master's Hands (Jeremiah 26:14) designed to work His ways in the manner He has planned. We were chosen to bear fruit (John 15:16). So, let us bear fruit.

#5 Strive to Establish Like-mindedness

2 Cor 13:11 says, "Finally, brothers, Rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort one another, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you". These are the attributes we have to work towardswhich brings like-mindedness held together because God is at the centre.

#6 Stay Humble

"Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." (1 Peter 5:5). Pride leads to every other vice: it is the complete anti-God state of mind (C. S. LEWIS, Mere Christianity). Let us therefore stay away from this and ask for God's grace to restore and maintain Humility in our lives.

#7 See the good in others

It never hurts to Compliment people, magnify their strengths and not their weakness. Make someone feel good by pointing the good in them. This would help you foster a relationship of trust that builds the base for intervening peaceably when they go off-track.

#8 Respond with love

Our responses should gentle with love and grounded in the WOG and His Love (**Proverbs 15:1**... A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger).

#9 Remind people that they are Worthy

Remind them they are worthy for they are all lovingly created in the image of the most high God.... "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them" (Genesis 1:27). Your value begins with the fact that you are made by the hand of the Creator in His very image. "Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God!" (1 John 3:1). God actually considers you His very own precious child. So, instil the powerful Word of God as and when the opportunity arises. Create the opportunities guided by the Spirit of God and step forward for encounters with people.

#10 Listen with Patience and Self-control

We cannot build a brother or a sister or a friend unless we have the heart to listen.

James in 1:19 says, "My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry. Exercise patience and self-control". Let us not downplay another person's situation but rather "Be open and considerate". Everyone's burden is difficult for them to bear. So, let us not compare and belittle their struggles.

As **Builders**, we require,

- a mentor who constantly builds us up, who we are accountable to, someone who is willing to call us out when we are wrong, someone from whom we can learn something new, someone who is a prayer pillar of support.
- ii) to be assertive as against the worldly norms that calls us to be aggressive to achieve something.
- iii) to continuously refresh and nourish ourselves. The Bible very clearly says in **Hebrews 5:12-14** that we need someone to teach us AGAIN the basic principles of the oracles of God
- iv) to always retrospect and see how things can be done in a better and meaningful way and most important of all.
- v) to be less dependent on ourselves and increasingly dependent on Christ.

Joyce Meyer said it beautifully when she said, "Teachers can change lives with just the right mix of chalk and challenges".

Therefore, let us not stick to old tattered notes we have assimilated over the ages in course of our career but let us first and foremost refresh ourselves with the Word of God and see old things in a new light, a new perspective, seeking ways in which we can build better relationships and in turn, do our part in building someone's life. Let us take the time to rise up and make a difference.

A special thanks to Pst. Suhas Bawadekar and Bro. Shekar for their help and guidance.


