Dear Friends,

Availing loan has become quite a common feature for any one across the world. Availing educational loan has come as a remedy for higher studies and cross cultural education at any level. In the light of the word of God, our life is also not our own and it is on loan from God. According to scripture, God created earth for mankind and we are the stewards of His creation to manage it for Him.

The beginning of all Biblical stewardship principles begins with the very first verse of the Bible."In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." (Gen.1:1). The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it (Ps.24:1) The foundation of stewardship is built upon the reality that God created everything and created everything for Him. "For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth all things were created through him and for him" (Col. 1:15-16). Not only did God create everything but God owns everything(Job 41:11; 1 Tim. 4:3-5). God desires everything to bring Him glory(Col. 1:20,1 Cor. 10:31). All things to be redeemed include people,

nature, governments, businesses, education, arts and science. "For we are God's fellow workers and working together with him (1Cor. 3:9; 2Cor. 6:1). God is at work in our life and around the world, and we have the privilege of participating in His work.

While we concentrated on teachers being the fellow workers with God in the previous issue of *Chalk and Chai*, it is quite meaningful and useful to reflect on "Teachers as stewards of the Kingdom" in this issue. We are called to be stewards of everything for His glory and for the good of others.

I would like to highlight a few principles of stewardship with respect to **Space**, **Matter and Time**.

Stewardship and Resources

Many scientists speak of it as a Space-Matter-Time continuum including energy as a form of matter. In our day to day life, they still remain as continuum and we are called to steward these resources. We have a place to live and work (space). It involves money and materials (matter) and we work to earn our livelihood and use it. (energy). Working place is what God has set for each one of us on this

earth. We are called to work as stewards and steward all these resources for saving, giving and helping.

In the Bible we read that God created everything for Adam and called him to "work" and to take care of the garden on His behalf. We are created to work. Jesus knew the value of work, spending the first 30 years of his life working with his hands as a carpenter. Paul reminds us "...aspire to live quietly, and to mind your own affairs, and to work with your hands, as we instructed you, so that you may walk properly before outsiders and be dependent on no one"(1 Thess.4:11-12). When we work to earn for our livelihood, we have to save money for future. It's not to love money but to be content with what we have (Heb. 13:5) and continue to trust in the Lord as we do not know what tomorrow will bring(James 4:14). As a steward of the resources which God has given us, we need to manage them in such a way that we can provide monetary gifts, food, and clothing, or just being hospitable with what we have for the needs of our family (1 Tim. 5:8), our church (Gal. 6:6; 1 Tim. 5:17-18), and those in society (Matt. 25:35-40; 1 John3:17). Jesus our Master teacher has set an example. He looked up to His Father in Heaven for His resources. He did not waste the resources of the earth. Even after he fed the multitude, he gathered the leftovers and filled twelve baskets once and seven baskets another time.

As stewards we believe that our times are in God's hands (Ps 31:15) and we will seek His wisdom to utilize the time as stewards. Teach us to

number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom (Psalm 90:12). As stewards, like Paul we have to learn to depend on the Lord for His strength both mentally and physically. "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Phil 4:13).

Stewardship and Responsibility

In the New Testament, the word "steward" is rooted in the Greek word. "oikonomos", which means "the manager of a household."The responsible management of these God-given resources is called stewardship. It reminds us that God owns everything of Space Matter and Time and we are simply managers or administrators acting on His behalf to manage our life for the purpose for what He has created us. Joseph is the perfect example of what it means to be a steward."So Joseph found favour in his sight and attended him, and he made him overseer of his house and put him in charge of all that he had" (Gen. 39:4). Joseph didn't own anything but he was given stewardship over the house and everything his master owned.

Our stewardship of creation involves our responsibility in taking care of our own selves our families and communities, the environment and animals as well. While we admire and appreciate God's gift of creation with all its resources, we should also accept our responsibility. While the greedy human race is failing to be stewards of God's creation, as Christian stewards we are called to be sensitive to the environment and resources of this earth. They are respectful of all human life and recognize that we are co-

labourers with almighty God in the ongoing work of creation. As the owner of everything, God makes his desires for his creation known to His people through Moses. Moses was told to let the people farm the land for six years, but to make them take a break from farming the ground in the seventh year.(Leviticus 25:1-5). God in His creative work schedule set the seventh day free from work. He commanded the Israelites not to gather Manna on the seventh day. He taught them work ethics to work for six days and rest on the seventh day which was applicable to the animals also. We are responsible to steward space time and energy in keeping a clean environment both in the working place as well in our living place, maintaining discipline and orderliness, finishing the task and assignments in the expected time, taking care of our physical health and setting time to rest and relax. While we complain about our rights here on earth, the Bible constantly reminds us about our responsibilities. Friends, remember that owners have rights but stewards have responsibilities.

Stewardship and Reward

We are all stewards of the resources, abilities and opportunities that God has entrusted to our care, and one day each one of us will be called to give an account for how we have managed what the Master has given us. Like the servants in the Parable of the Talents, we will be called to give an account of how we have administered everything in the space, matter and time. "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an

inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving (Col. 3:23-24). Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness" (Mt.25:21).

As Christian teachers in the 21st century, may the Lord help us to embrace the larger biblical view of stewardship to apply in our day to day life where theconcepts of faith, work and economics intersectand help us to teach and promote them in the lives of the younger generation in building His kingdom on this earth.

The Breastplate of the High Priests was adorned by 12 beautiful precious stones representative of the 12 Tribes of Israel. Each one with matchless self-worth, radiant and colorful, yet different from each other. The Master Creator designed mankind likewise. No two persons are identical. Each one is uniquely blessed and endowed with gifts from above.

The different stones on the High priests breastplate were indicative of the variations among the flocks of Israel. These stones are different because of the differing materials that make up their composition and the process of formation each stone has undergone. Likewise, each one of us are molded in different ways through the various trials we have gone through and the different crucibles we have to shoulder. Yet these formative steps result in the production of souls worthy of shining forth the light of Christ to the flock. When the likeminded children of God work in unison bound by the Holy Spirit, then they coordinate perfectly wanting nothing. Such is the power vested in the community of Believing Teachers in Christ.

PRECIOUS STONES IN THE BREASTPLATE OF HIGH PRIESTS

(explanations for each stone are taken from "God's Precious Jewels" by Frederick Lardent, who is also the Author of "The Hidden Meaning of Bible Colours" & "An Instrument of Ten Strings").

Jewels not only represent the Elect of God but they also serve to remind us of the basic teachings of the Bible.

RUBY: Originally called as "Odem", it means "Blood Red" which signifies "taken out of red earth" (Gen. 3:19). It is red earth or clay in crystallized form. It's colour is due to the oxide of iron which also give blood its colour. Hence Ruby has been called as

"petrified blood". Adam was the bright iewel of all natural creation but on account of sin, he gradually lost his glory and luster. Then, Jesus came to take the sinner's place. His blood was precious because He knew no sin. He became the world's High Priest(Heb. 5:1). Hence, Jesus Christ is a jewel so exceedingly precious. In Rev. 4:3, we read. "And He that sat was to look unto like a jasper and a sardine stone(Ruby) and there was a rainbow about the throne in sight like unto an emerald". The name engraved on the first jewel of the breastplate was "Reuben", the eldest son of Jacob who was the representative of the family in the absence of his father. Like Jesus, the Anointed is the representative of the Heavenly Father and the beginning of the creation of God(Rev. 3:14). To Him will all mankind look for guidance and judgment when "the government will be upon His shoulders(Isaiah 9:6,7).

TOPAZ: It has been named the second in the Breastplate. As Ruskin puts it, this stone is reminiscent of the sun shining with a golden light, standing between light and darkness and representative of "All Good Work". In addition to this, Topaz is strongly electrical in nature and distinguished itself from other stones bearing a similar appearance. These qualities draw us to Psalm 84:11 which describes our God as a sun and shield. The magnetic power of Topaz suggest the attraction which God's jewels possess for Himself.

CARBUNCLE: This word means "burning coal" which is apt for its fiery appearance. It is electric by friction and affects the magnetic needle. This

describes well, the fiery judgment of the Lord which burns against all injustice and unrighteousness, God the consuming fire, His eyes are a flame of fire(Psalm 18:13,14/ Hebrews 12:29/ Rev. 19:11,12).

EMERALD: A beautiful grass green stone whose colour was initially thought to be due to a mineral oxide. But it is now believed to be produced by Chlorphyll. This thought has been validated by the fact that the stone loses its colour when it is subjected to heat whereas those tinted by mineral oxides remain unaffected. Cholorophyll is the life-giving green sap of plants and hence this stone is a striking emblem of Eternal Life (John 5:26;Rev. 4:3;2 Peter 1:4).

SAPPHIRE: A beautiful sky blue coloured stone, its hardness is equal to that of the Ruby and almost approaches to that of diamond. Very Valuable and highly prized, the heavenly blue of the sapphire reminds us of God and the unchanging laws which govern the universe. It has come to be the emblem of "Faithfulness" (Psam 36:5; 89:2). This blue colour has a very prominent place amongst sacred colours. The high priest had a Blue



robe underneath his ephod and the breastplate was fixed by a Blue lace(Exodus 28:28,31). The furnishings of the tabernacle were covered with a cloth of blue to remind the Israelites of their need of faithfully fulfilling the Divine requirements (Num. 4:5-12).

The Sapphire of the Breastplate indicated the faithfulness of God's precious jewels in the performance of their vows of sacrifice.

We as precious jewels are called to faithfulness in our deeds and to be faithful stewards of the responsibility entrusted on us.

BERYL: This is one of the foundation stones of New Jerusalem. True Beryl was a pale greenish blue coloured stone composed of silica with the addition of colouring matter. This resembles sea water. In Rev. 15:2, the saints are depicted as "standing on the sea of glass having harps of God". This pictures a possession of lucid truths which make them happy and confident in the love of God. Our Lord Jesus is Truth personified as He says, "I am the Way, the Truth and the

Life". On the other end of the spectrum, when the Israelites wandered the wilderness of sin, we read in Deut. 8:15 of the One "who brought forth water out of the rock of flint". 1 Cor. 10:4 reads, "They drank of the spiritual Rock that went with them, which Rock was Christ. Thus this stone represents "TRUTH".

LIGURE: This is the jacinth of the New Testament(Rev. 21:20). It has various colours - red, blue, orange, purple, etc. hence the colour is not used to understand it's symbolic meaning. This stone distinguishes itself from the other gems because of its strong double refraction after the order of the tourmaline. They have exceptional optical properties. If this stone is place on a single line, it appears as two distinct lines. Hence. mankind has a double portion in store - one on earth i.e.peace, life, happiness in addition to being like God and possessing immortality. The inheritance awaiting the Church is beautifully expressed in 1 Cor. 2: 9 which says, "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither hath it entered into the heart of man, the things that God hath prepared for them that love Him".



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AGATE: It is composed of sand. Moses alludes to the tribe of Issachar as "treasure hid in the sand" which aptly represents the production of agate(Deut.33:19). This jewel speaks of "treasures hidden in earthen vessels (2Cor.4:7). It indicates the fiery experiences that changes sand into gems of value. In Gen. 22:17, mankind is likened to the "sand by the seashore".

When people of God go through their crucibles in preparation for eternal life, they lose their identity as human beings in order to dwell with God. They are spoken of as "Jewels" with a reward in heaven.

AMETHYST: It's violet colour is due to the presence of the oxide of manganese. Violet or Purple is a symbol of "Royalty". Violet is a mixture of Blue and Red which means "Faithful unto Death". Our Master was clad in a purple robe. Rev. 2:10 tells us to "Be faithful unto death and I will give thee a Crown of Life". The Greek meaning of Amethyst means "not to intoxicate". The stone, the colour of wine, also represents the cup of wine the Lord passed to His disciples during the Last Supper. This cup was representative of experience, sorrow, joy which each believer of the Lord must drink. This cup does not lead to intoxication but rather, it brings the spirit of sound mind(2 Tim. 1:7).

This stone in the Breastplate indicates the Honoured Title and the Office of Royalty from the Overcomer(1 Pet. 2:29).

CHRYSOLITE: This stone literally means "Gold-stone" similar to yellow diamond. Gold represents things Divine and the understanding of spiritual truths resulting in Heavenly Wisdom borne out in the several visions of Prophet of Ezekiel (Eze. 1:16; 10:9).

Chrysolite is remarkably similar to Topaz in appearance, the distinguishing feature being the electrical energy of Topaz. Divine Love and Divine Wisdom bear a striking relationship. One is impossible without the other (1Cor. 13;Gal.5:22,23;James 3:17).

Divine Love has this difference; it is warm, fervent and extremely pleasant in its drawing power. It is the sum total of God's Character – For God is Love which is illustrated as the inherent electrical energy of topaz. Divine Wisdom, on the other hand, is calm and reflective. (Prov.8:22). This tranquility of God is well portrayed by Chrysolite.

ONYX: This stone may be white, black and red, a pair of which adorns the shoulders of the High Priest (Exo. 28:9-14). Various layers are seen as separate stone although they are actually one layer alone. They represent the basic truths, which, while distinct from each other are inseparable. Onyx proclaims the taking away of the sin of the world(Black) through the Blood of Christ(Red). So that all the people of the earth will become pure, holy and righteous – the emblem of white(Rev. 20:11,12).

DIAMOND: When symmetrically cut and polished, the rough diamond is transformed into a gem which is beautiful, valuable and long lasting. But remember. Diamond is nothing but a piece of crystallized charcoal. This originally soft black and grimy soot becomes the hardest known crystals in the Divine Laboratory. It is characterized by its Strength and Beauty. Psalm 96:6 says, "Strength and Beauty are in Thy Sanctuary". These characters are instilled in us with the receiving of the Holy Spirit of Truth.

It has been said that, "It takes a diamond to cut a diamond". Diamond dust is necessary to polish the gem, which implies the immense value of "Fellowship of Kindred Minds".

Twelve in all, but each one distinct from the other!

In the community of Teachers, every single one is a precious gem fashioned by the Master Craftsman. Each one of us was created to serve a purpose according to the plan that the Master Planner has designed for us. Each one of us is blessed with multifarious talents. Each one is unique. Each one of us is called to be 'Faithful Stewards' for the kingdom of God on this earth. God's Kingdom operates on the principle of

"Stewardship". We are accountable for the talents bestowed on us. Do we choose to hide these talents or do we choose to multiply them for His Glory??

We are stewards of everything we have been given- our time, money, abilities, information, wisdom, relationships, and authority.

Bridging my career

with Cambridge

I hail from a picturesque town called Sawyerpuram, near the pearl city of Tuticorin, in the southernmost part of the Indian sub-continent. Born in a Christian home. I was brought up in the fear of the Lord and in Christian virtues. I was passionate about teaching as both my parents were teachers. After my post-graduation in Physics from American College, Madurai, I completed my M.Sc (Enga) at Indian Institute of Science. Bangalore. With a few years of teaching experience in Bangalore colleges, I settled down to teach Physics at National Public School. Indiranagar (NPS-I), a school known for its academic excellence globally.

It is said. "What a teacher is, is more important than what she teaches". It is the call of every teacher to be caring, nurturing and motivating. Teaching is a very challenging profession as it teaches all the other professions. As teachers, we need to be versatile, passionate, open to changes and adopt strategies to suit all kinds of learners. Traditional lecture based methods of teaching have become out of tune and a paradigm shift in teaching methods is

mandatory. Non-conventional and child-centric methods of teaching are compulsory to be an effective teacher.

Over a period of time, I realised that my learners' needs weren't met by the conventional techniques I was following. To bridge the gap, I began to look out for innovative teaching methods. Unexpectedly my school gave an invitation to register for Cambridge International Certification in Teaching and Learning (CICTL). I grabbed the opportunity delightfully with both my hands. The face-to-face sessions of CICTL were profoundly effective and relevant to reach out to today's learners, what exactly I was looking for. The highlights are active learning methods a teacher has to adopt with tailor made lesson plans



for each class where the learner is the point of focus, learning theories, multiple intelligence in children and assessment techniques. These techniques, when adopted, require a lot of teacher's preparation time prior to the class, however learning is maximised in each learner and concepts go into their long term memory.

The assessment of the course involved two parts: the first part was two demonstration classes evaluated by my mentors and the second part was submitting six essays to Cambridge University. My mentors gave very good feedback for the two classes; the real challenge was to write the essays. I used to pray that if Dr G U Pope, the Anglican missionary to Sawyerpuram a century and a half ago, could translate Tamil Books to English, it is nothing for God to give me the wisdom to put down my

thoughts in commendable English accepted by the Cambridge University. The Lord opened all possible avenues to access the necessary resources to write those essays. Currently the essays are being reviewed by my mentors and I am confident that the Lord will make me complete the course. All I can sav with confidence is that, this path of learning has been tough and challenging but I am now a transformed teacher to reach out to each of my learners with a new zeal and enthusiasm. Glory to Him who fills everything in every way!!

"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has lost his flavour, wherewith shall it be salted?" "You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men that they may see your good deeds and praise your father in heaven" Mathew 5: 13-16

Jesus, in His sermon on the mount described His disciples as "salt" and "light" to the society. Salt is required to give taste and to prevent decays, while light is to remove darkness. The responsibility of being the salt and the light is much deeper than we can perceive. In a world that is increasingly becoming a chaotic rubble, it is His expectation that His disciples will emerge as the way forward to bring it to an order against the odds. It is clear that a disciple with the character, lifestyle and priorities as mentioned in the Sermon on the Mount is bound to emerge as SALT and LIGHT to the world. Therefore, I consider that the only pre-requisite for emerging as SALT and LIGHT to the world (which is otherwise tasteless and dark) is

emphatically, the practice of the Sermon on the Mount. With that as the keynote, let us discuss engaging the universities as Disciples of Christ.

The Legacy of Universities


The earliest universities (e.g. The University of Paris and the University of Oxford in the AD 1100s and several others that followed in Europe and elsewhere) was the work of God's people, when they felt the need for deeper studies and debates on the various disciplines. These universities used to function in a close association with the church. The relationship between the scholars in the church and the University was profound and intriguing. These universities not only became centres

of theology, philosophy and science, but also became incubators of the Renaissance and the Reformation that followed in the world history. In a sense, it was the scholars from the universities and the church together that influenced the world further in its graduation from medieval to the modern era. There can be debates on how much of saltiness was there in the 'salt of the earth' at that time, yet history can't deny the influence of several God's people in the Renaissance and Reformation and the world's journey further to the advancements that we find today.

At a time when we have a large number of universities, let us consider our call to be the 'salt and light' influence in and through the universities afresh. Let us look at the possibilities in two dimensions;

Engage to WITNESS

ESI's third Aim is; "TO RAISE IN COLLEGES A TESTIMONY TO THE TRUTH OF THE HISTORIC CHRISTIAN FAITH, AND PRESENT ITS MESSAGE THERE OF, AS A SOLUTION FOR THE PROBLEMS OF MANKIND"



Campuses these days are flooded with issues and problems of mankind get discussed there. Amidst these, it is the responsibility of the disciples of Christ (see the overlapping segment in picture - disciples of Christ in university) to bring those to the throne of God for solutions. God in His mercies will equip the disciples with solutions that will align with the historic Christian faith.

Recently a well-known campus in Kerala decided to discuss about LGBT and section 377 of the Indian Penal Code. Based on the convictions of the leaders in the campuses, a number of people from different walks of life were called and they were giving lectures and their perspectives on the issue. The question is, can worldly wisdom offer a solution to this issue that is gripping the minds of several young people? Absolutely not. Hence, the dsciples of Christ in the same campus should bring it to the throne of God's grace, seek Godly wisdom and express the same in formal and informal forums in the campus. As a movement, UESI has been known for this, all through our 65 years, starting from our founding fathers like Prof H Enoch who took a stand in Zoology against the pseudo sciences of his times and HS Ponnuraj for his work in Agriculture.

In the early 2000s, when Dan Brown's book, "The Da Vinci Code" was released, it raised a lot of questions in the minds of young people. At that time, a number of UESI groups considered it important to let the campuses know the truth about the matter, and present the

historically accurate version of it. A city EGF conducted a programme, "Da Vinci- The Truth Does Matter" and it was an opportunity for hundreds of people to know and understand the truth about the matter, reaffirming the historic Christian faith.

Let our students (the overlapping segment of the picture, - disciples of Christ in the University) be equipped to take a stand on issues like these in the campuses. Students, while being witnesses must apply the WWJD (What Would Jesus Do) principle in each of these situations; pray and explore God's word and take the Christian stand that will provide solutions to the problems in discussions.

Incidentally, several students in the campuses are puzzled and are seeking good and godly answers to several of their questions. Therefore, it is not just a responsibility but also an opportunity for leading several of our friends to God.

Beyond the few issues we always talk about, like - caste, dowry, corruption, pseudo sciences, LGBT, there are several more to discussthese include political issues within



the country to international issues, from stewardship of technology advancements to the ethics in newer technologies and thoughts; Al, Block Chain and so on. Let these questions be brought to the Lord for His answers to our EU students and through them as answers to the problems of mankind. So, let us engage the students to witness in the university.

Engage to Worship

A second / deeper dimension of our 'engaging the university, should be that the overlapping segment (disciples of Christ in the university) to get back to the church with more offerings in worship. Offerings, in terms of new discoveries that will glorify God in their fields of research and studies in the university. While in the university, we often forget that the fields of university too are created by God and for His glory. And as His disciples in campuses we are studying His world and no other. The God of the Bible is the owner of the field of our studies. May it be Pure Sciences, Applied Sciences, Economics, Commerce, Art, Literature, Culture, History and Politics, and so on, He is the author and owner of these domains. He created these with His great plans and purposes as described in the Scripture right from Genesis. For by Him all things where created - things in heaven and on earth - visible and invisible All things were created by Him and for Him ... In Him all things hold together. (Col: 3: 16-17).

The creation mandate rule and subdue (Gen 1:28), work in and take



care (Gen 2:15) of the creation calls us to explore the world and bring forth offerings of worship to the Lord from our fields...

For instance, a physics student as a disciple of Christ should dig deeper in the subject to bring glory and honour to the God of Physics. By the way, only few, even those in the field of Physics know that Sir Isaac Newton, hailed as the father of modern physics, was a follower of Christ. He firmly believed in God and worshipped Him while deeply engaging in Physics, discovering and formulating the laws of motion, gravity and so on. In fact, he wrote many studies on the books of the Bible (studies on the prophetic books like Daniel and Revelation) in addition to his theses in Physics. It was not secular and sacred sides of Newton's life, but an integrated life. He drew his inspiration to engage in Physics as a quest to know more about God's creation and the physical laws that He set in place. And he worshipped God with his findings and discoveries in the world of science.

It is interesting to read the epitaph on Newton's tomb at the Westminster's' abbey. "Here is buried Isaac Newton, Knight, who by a strength of mind almost divine, and mathe-

matical principles peculiarly his own. explored the course and figures of the planets, the paths of comets, the tides of the sea, the dissimilarities in rays of light, and, what no other scholar has previously imagined, the properties of the colors thus produced. Diligent, sagacious and faithful, in his expositions of nature. antiquity and the holy Scriptures, he vindicated by his philosophy the majesty of God mighty and good, and expressed the simplicity of the Gospel in his manners. Mortals rejoice that there has existed such and so great an ornament of the human race! He was born on 25 December 1642, and died on 20 March 1726

Is it exaggerating to say that Sir Isaac Newton, worshipped the Lord of Physics with His discoveries in Physics (and Mathematics)?

Lord Kelvin, who formulated the laws of thermodynamics and paved way for a flood of discoveries and inventions, was also a follower of Christ. In fact, he was an elder in his church along with his practice as a physicist. In response to the growing atheism of his times (after the Darwin's theory etc), he said, "I believe that the more thoroughly science is studied, the farther does it take us from anything comparable to atheism. Do not be afraid to be free thinkers. If you think strongly enough, you will be forced by science to the belief in God"

Louis Pasteur, hailed as the father of Microbiology, who developed "pasteurization" has said, "The more

I study nature, the more I stand amazed at the work of the Creator." "Science brings men nearer to God."

Joseph John Thompson, who discovered the "electrons" said, " In the distance tower still higher



[scientific] peaks which will yield to those who ascend them still wider prospects and deepen the feeling whose truth is emphasized by every advance in science, that

great are the works of the Lord." (Statement in Nature)

James Joule, the physicist who worked on the Kinetic Theory of Gases, also discovered the "Joule-Thomson" effect—paved a way for further inventions in refrigeration and



air conditioning. He also said, "It is evident that an acquaintance with natural laws means no less than an

acquaintance with the mind of God therein expressed." "Order is manifestly maintained in the universe...governed by the sovereign will of God" "After the knowledge of, and obedience to, the will of God, the next aim must be to know something of His attributes of wisdom, power, and goodness as evidenced by His handiwork."

By the way "Joule" is a unit of energy in physics today.



These people of God were truly exercising the Genesis mandate of ruling and subduing the earth by their

offerings in their respective fields. In fact there is a host of such men and women of God, who are known for their creative engagement in their fields and worshipped / glorified God

with their findings, discoveries, new know-hows and contributions in their fields. While C S Lewis can be termed as a missionary in literature



and philosophy (think of Chronicles of Narnia), **William Wilberforce** can be termed as missionary in Politics and governance. The list is endless. All of them have let His light shine through them and their work in their disciplines are still glorifying the Father.

Conclusion

It is true that Man with his sinful nature has corrupted many of these fields by his fallen priorities without any accountability to God. So many things in the fields of our studies may not be in accordance with God's purposes now and His plans for the future. However, God in His mercy

accounted for its redemption in the mission of Christ "For God was pleased to have His fullness dwell in Him (Christ) and through Him reconcile to Himself ALL thin-



gs- whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through His blood, shed on the cross. (Col: 3: 19-20). The need for redemption of many fields of our studies is more than obvious than ever. So, let us engage the campuses as His witnesses giving His answers.

Let us also should remind ourselves, in the light of Genesis 1 & 2, that God created us for a creative engagement (and enjoyment too) in the fields that we study, and called to engage, bringing offerings of worship from our fields, so as people from the fields of our studies, drawing them to the author and owner of our fields.

Campuses are happening places....

The knowledge base in every field is getting upgraded at a fast pace there. Even before we get used to something new, something newer appears. As people of God in the campuses, we should study, pray and seek God's mind in these things. As we pray and engage in our fields as His agents /stewards, God will reveal His further plans in the things that we study- to witness unto Him and to worship Him. Surely better and Godly things will emerge as a result, for which we can claim His promises for His glory. For instance, while studying economic policies, praying to God, seeking wisdom to tackle the current world issues like poverty, unemployment, price rise, inflation etc, God will reveal better ideas- in line with His eternal purposes (See Amos 3:7)

The Scripture, through its inspired narratives and throughout its wide landscape of human history, reveals to us how God dealt with people on a variety of issues in their daily walks and challenges of their times. If studied in its context with prayers, we can get insights and answers to the problems in our contexts, our fields of studies and engagements too.

So, in effect, through the study of God's word and constant communion with God, we should engage our campuses and fields of studies with His insights (what He want to do further in those fields for His glory). Let us engage in the campuses with such Godly thoughts / ideas/ wisdom /technologies/policies - witnessing and worshipping Him in our fields. Beyond innovations, inno-visions will emerge when followers of Christ serve as "Stewards of Theology" in Economics, Physics, Chemistry, Political Science, Law, Engineering and so on. May the Lord help us to be His light, engaging in the campuses as His witnesses and worshippers, living out His concerns for the fields of our studies.


